

David Arthur Binns, a beloved husband, father, brother, uncle, counsellor and teacher, passed away in the warm embrace of his family on July 9, 2024. After a year-long battle against bone marrow cancer and in a very weakened state at Newmarket's Southlake Regional Hospital, he was peacefully called back to God at the age of 79 years.

David was born in Toronto on September 27, 1944 as the first born son of the late Wilfred & Mary Binns of Bolton. 

David's long teaching and guidance counselling career began in a one-room schoolhouse in McKellar, Ontario. More than five decades later he had taught in at least three different Toronto public school boards before transferring to the Catholic Separate School Board - St. Thomas Aguinas Secondary School in nearby Tottenham.

David's love of sports combined with his teaching skills lead him to coach students who excelled at both golfing and archery bringing home several awards of distinction. He was an avid Blue Jays & Leafs fan rarely missing a game. He never missed an opportunity to take either a family member to a game or to reward his Squire's church youth group with game tickets. He single-handedly organised fundraisers, fun activities, monthly meetings, and yearly convention trips for more than ten years. David was much loved and respected by so many of his committed and gifted students over the many years teaching, counselling, and always encouraging them to become mature and well-rounded adults.
