Few things in life are as painful as watching a loved one drift away from Jesus. It may start as a seemingly small departure, nothing to be alarmed about. But one day you realize — and it takes your breath away to realize it — your loved one's soul has been drifting away. He or she travels further and further away into unbelief and unrepentant sin.

The beginning of <u>James 5:19</u> happens before your very eyes: "My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth . . ." Here we find the afflictive prepositional phrase — the one that keeps you up at night, sheds your tears, and breaks your heart: "if anyone among you wanders."

Once he stood beside you as a brother born for the day of adversity. Once she would stay up all night praying with you. Once he even led you to the Lord Jesus. But now what is he? What is she? *Shrinking back, lukewarm, rocky soil*? Are they going out from us because somehow, someway, they were never truly of us?

The fearful soul that tires and faints,
And walks the ways of God no more,
Is but esteemed almost a saint,
And makes his own destruction sure. ("The Almost Christian")

Is Isaac Watts right? Are they proving themselves "almost saints"? Are they making their own destruction sure? You feel so helpless as you see them off in the distance. On some days, you may wish to have already been away from the body and at home with the Lord before seeing what your eyes now see. Hope deferred has made your heart sick.

Do you know someone who is wandering away from Jesus? God has a word for you, for us, in the concluding verses of James as he talks to the church of wanderers.

My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back, *let him know* that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins. (James 5:19–20)

Brothers:

This is the motto of the Columbian Squires and it reminds them to live out the virtues and ideals of their Fraternal Group as young Catholic role models. These ideals include Faith, Service, Charity, Leadership, Moral Character, Fraternity, Community Participation and Personal Growth. The St Paul Columbian Squires have tried their best to build on these principles not only in their Circle's activities but in their lives as well this past year.

Some past activities have included, collecting food for the Alliston Food Bank formally known as Good Sheppard Food Bank, Movie Nights, a Joint Pancake Supper & Patrick's Day Breakfast with the Parish Youth Ministry, Rosary, Stations of the Cross, and other St Paul the Apostle Youth Ministry Events.

Plans include a community Food Drive & Drive & Breakfast fundraiser, Joint Squires/Youth Ministry Activities such as a Pancake Tuesday Dinner, and Youth Ministry Pasta Night. Spiritually, they are organizing to attend the Ontario State Squires Advent Retreat in Stouffville, joining you, the Knights, this lent to pray the rosary and stations of the Cross and on a fraternal note, attendance at the Ontario Knights of Columbus and Columbian Squires State Conventions. At these conventions we will be participating in the *125th Anniversary of the Knights in Ontario* but also the 100 th Anniversary of the Founding of Columbian Squires by Brother Barnabas Macdonald.

Currently there are 7 active members and there has been interest from a few youths within the Parish. To expand the membership, a membership drive is being rethought and will be reviewed with Father shortly. This plan will focus on attracting male students within the 3 local Catholic Elementary Schools, Catholic High School and our Parish through activities, information talks, displays and advertisement posters. Furthermore, in conjunction with the State Squires Board, State Director and Regional Chairperson other local Knights of Columbus Councils will be asked to consider joining in the expansion of St Paul the Apostle Circle in their area. Yes, this sounds ambitious and confusing but so do so many things when they are first thought of and often an opportunity is lost or discouraged prematurely.

St Pope John Paul II was often told to give up on his belief in young people and his "crazy Idea" of a gathering of young people. When confronted with this discouragement, he would often respond, "Do not be afraid. Open wide the doors for Christ. Trust!" He proved many skeptics wrong when in 1984 over 700,000 pilgrims descended on Rome, Italy for 4 days of catechisms, prayer and celebration with the Holy Father. The following year World Youth Day was established and has continued ever since each Palm Sunday in dioceses around the World as well as every few years with a world gathering of young people.

Jealousy and selfishness are usually the root beneath every scandal in the Church, every division on the parish staff, every discord among ministries, every disappointed volunteer who feels pushed out, every broken relationship in Christian families, and every attitude that chases weaker Catholics away from the faith — it's all wicked!

To get at the root of any divisive problem, look for self-centered ambition. Honestly and objectively identify even the most subtle forms of it so that you can also identify God's antidote. When you see divisiveness in others, do you feel sorrow for them? If not, why not? The answer to that usually lies in our own self-centered pride.

Jesus provided the cure for this: "If anyone wishes to be first" (which is a desire motivated by selfish ambition) "you must become the servant of all."

Selfish ambition is sinful because it tries to grab success away from others. James pointed out that whatever we're ambitious for, if it's good, we can have it simply by asking God for it and working in collaboration with the Holy Spirit to achieve our goals — but not if we want it only to satisfy our personal, selfish passions.

God gives us what we pray for when it will benefit the parish community or the entire family or those we are called to serve in our ministries. When we desire something for the sake of how it will help others (rather than just for our own benefit), this desire is pure, peaceable, gentle, compliant, and full of mercy and will produce good fruits.




